About QOMSBOC: QOMSBOC is a highly regarded symposium organized annually by synthetic and bioorganic research chemists from Quebec and Ontario, Canada. Hosted by a different academic institution each year, QOMSBOC provides a platform to present innovative research, with a particular emphasis on graduate students, undergraduates, and postdoctoral researchers. The primary mission of QOMSBOC is to inspire and contribute to the training of the next generation of exceptional young organic and bioorganic chemists.

About EWOC EastCan: EWOC (Empowering Women in Organic Chemistry) is an organization that recognizes, identifies, and helps retain women in organic chemistry. Established in December 2021 with the support of other chapters, the Eastern Canada Chapter, (EWOC EastCan), aims to build a supportive network and connect women in chemistry and non-binary people and their allies in Ontario, Québec and the Maritime provinces. The chapter's mission aligns with EWOC's core values, striving to promote excellence, facilitate collaboration between academia and industry, share personal experiences, and host workshops. The chapter seeks to inspire and drive diversity within the chemistry domain. The EWOC EastCan Board is comprised of several students, academics, and industrial chemists across Eastern Canada.

QOMSBOC traditionally attracts approximately 200 attendees from more than a dozen universities, including the University of Toronto, University of Ottawa, Université de Montréal, University of Waterloo, and many others.
